ACCEPTABLE IDENTIFICATION DOCUMENTATION

As part of guidelines from the **National Vetting Bureau** the **100 point personal identification system** is used to verify the identity of all applicants for Garda Vetting. Details can be found on the Garda Síochána e-vetting website. Below is a brief synopsis of acceptable forms of identification.

When submitting your **E-Vetting Invitation form** it must be supported by Identification Documentation equalling at least 100 points on the Garda Vetting 100 point identification system. At least one form of photographic evidence must be submitted. This applies to all applicants.

Exception: Entry to the College via the CAO system will be considered the equivalent of a Birth Certificate and therefore will equal 50 points. Further photographic identification equalling at least 50 points should also be submitted along with your application. This should be photographic identification. A combination of two further forms of identification will be accepted provided the deficit of 50 points is achieved.

Example: If you submit a **National Age Card** this equals **25 points**. You will therefore need to submit identification equalling a further 25 points such as a membership card of a club or a medical card.

Please ensure that your identification documentation is fully certified before your submit it with your E-Vetting form.

Incomplete forms will not be accepted and will be returned to you.

Your Garda Vetting online form will be sent to you via an email containing a link, following submission of your E-Vetting Invitation Form and supporting documentation to the Garda Vetting Office. **Therefore please ensure you check your email from time to time.**
